COLOR MIXING CHART by Elnore A. Grow

In order to simplify your life, I recommend that you buy only FIVE dye colors. They can then be mixed to make most of the colors that you would want.

- 1. Turquoise
- 2. Fuchsia
- 3. Yellow
- 4. Purple
- 5. Black

TRUE BLUE-Start with a liter of turquoise (4-6 heaping teaspoons of dry dye) and add a small amount of fuchsia until you like the color.

BLUE- You can make blue with turquoise and purple (Mix until you like the color.)

TRUE RED-Start with a liter of fuchsia (4-6 tsps) and add a small amount of yellow.

ORANGE-Start with a liter of yellow (6-8 tsps) and add a small amount of fuchsia.

PURPLE-If you have not bought purple, you can make it with equal amounts of fuchsia and turquoise.

JADE GREEN- (TEAL) Make up your turquoise first, then add a small amount of yellow until you like the color.

PINK-Start with the water and add a small amount of fuchsia.

GREY- Start with water and add a small amount of Black.

BLACK-It is difficult to make a real black, so add plenty of dry dye (6-8 tsps) and still know that it may not be totally black.

MAROON-Start with the purple and add some fuchsia.

HAVE FUN! TRY AND DON'T BE AFRAID TO EXPERIMENT. YOU CAN BUY AS MANY COLORS AS YOU LIKE, BUT I FIND THAT BUYING ONLY FIVE COLORS SIMPLIFIES MY LIFE.
